1. Background and Job Purpose

The Ministry of Trade, Industry and Cooperatives with support from Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) under FAO–EU Forest Governance & Value Chains (FGVC) Programme is developing the **Wood Industry Information Management System (WIIMS)** as part of the National Timber traceability and legality assurance system known as **U-TIMBER**. The Wood Industry Information Management System (WIIMS) is responsible for registering processors, monitoring timber processing and trade flows, and generating traceability and compliance data for domestic and export markets

The Ministry wishes to recruit dedicated and competent staff to work as the Systems Development and Support Team (SDST) responsible for supporting the design, development, deployment, and long-term sustainability of the Wood Industry Information Management System (WIIMS).

The Ministry of Trade, Industry and Cooperatives therefore invites suitable qualified Ugandans to fill the vacancies existing in the Ministry under the **U-TIMBER Project**.

1. Job Title: Development Lead / DevOps Engineer

Job Purpose: To provide overall technical leadership; Manage Develops/Infrastructure functions to ensure secure architecture and design, reliable deployments and High Uptime; and Coordinate the development workflow, and ensures that all technical outputs align with system specifications and project requirements

Duties and Responsibilities

- Lead WIIMS system architecture design and ensure alignment with U-TIMBER standards.
- Translate functional requirements into technical specifications and assign development tasks.
- Supervise backend, frontend, mobile, DevOps, QA, and writing/graphics teams.
- Conduct code reviews, enforce coding/security standards, and optimize performance.
- Oversee integration with WEIS and other U-TIMBER components.
- Lead sprint planning, development cycles, and stakeholder technical meetings.
- Produce high-level technical documentation.
- Set up and maintain hosting infrastructure/environments for WIIMS (development, staging, production).
- Implement and manage CI/CD pipelines and automated deployment workflows.
- Configure monitoring, logging, alerts, and performance management tools; respond to incidents.
- Manage backups, disaster recovery, access controls, and cloud/security configurations.

- Maintain technical and infrastructure documentation, including deployment run books and architecture notes.

- Develop backend logic, APIs, and business rules for Wood Industry Information Management System (WIIMS)
- Design/optimize databases and ensure data integrity. Implement authentication, authorization, and secure data handling.

- Integrate WIIMS backend with WEIS and U-TIMBER Central services.
 - Debug backend issues, support quality assurance, and optimize server performance.
- Maintain backend documentation.

- Ensure cross-browser compatibility and performance.
- Integrate frontend with backend APIs.
- Support UI testing, bug fixing, and design improvements.
- Collaborate closely with the graphics designer

- Perform functional, regression, performance, and basic security testing.
- Log defects, verify fixes, and maintain issue trackers.
- Validate user workflows, data accuracy, and system outputs; support user acceptance testing (UAT).
- Prepare structured QA reports to inform release readiness and deployment decisions.
- Prepare user manuals, onboarding guides, and helpdesk support documents for WIIMS and U-TIMBER users.
- Maintain version-controlled documentation repositories and update documentation after releases.
